SD review (including Planned Interruption) and Customer Switching are proposed to be delivered 2021 or spill into 2022. Therefore, Q4, 2022 or later presents the least risk and optimal time to deliver for Gas Life Support. In addition, all gas market changes should be grouped together across East Coast and WA to align schemas at the same time.
