CONSULTATION ON CHANGES TO THE TRANSPORTATION SERVICE POINT REGISTER (TSPR)

The following notice is sent with respect to 3.2.4 of the Capacity Transfer and Auction Procedures (CTAP). AEMO is performing an *expedited* consultation on changes to the TSPR to publish data consistent to the CTAP section 24.2. Relevant *facility operators* and other interested stakeholders are invited to submit written comments on this proposal to AEMO by close of business Friday 25 February 2022.

AEMO notified stakeholders of these changes though the consultation on the CTAP in fourth quarter 2021 and through the Gas Wholesale Consultative Forum meeting on 9 December 2021.

1. OVERVIEW OF CHANGES

AEMO proposes the following changes to the TSPR to publish data consistent with CTAP section 24.2 where there is:

- information that relates to forward haul pipeline segments,
- information of more than one service points, including a GPG,
- information that has product components associated with all forward haul delivery points, are allocated to more than one pipeline delivery zone, and the aggregate nameplate capacity is greater than 100TJs.

The proposed amendments are non-material changes to current market operations. The changes require arrangement by AEMO for IT system updates.
