

## NATIONAL TRANSMISSION PLANNER CHARGES - 1 JANUARY 2021 TO 30 JUNE 2021

## National Transmission Planner Charges – 1 January 2021 – 30 June 2021

The National Electricity Rules were amended in 2020 to re-allocate recovery of AEMO's National Transmission Planner (NTP) costs from Market Customers to Transmission Network Service Providers (TNSPs).

The Rules include transitional arrangements to allow AEMO to commence charging TNSPs from 1 January 2021. Part of the budgeted NTP fees for 2020-21 are to be levied on TNSPs in 2020-21, with the remainder recovered from TNSPs (plus AEMO's financing of that amount) in 2021-22.

AEMO must, by 1 January 2021, publish on its website the NTP function fees for the period 1 January 2021 to 30 June 2021. Energy Networks Australia (on behalf of the TNSPs) and AEMO have agreed that a total of \$7m will be charged to TNSPs from 1 January 2021 to 30 June 2021. This amount excludes the Victorian jurisdiction, where an amount was included in the 2020-21 TUOS charges.

The charging of NTP function fees during the period to 30 June 2021 is based on the GWh consumed in the year commencing 1 July 2019 in the relevant region as a proportion of the GWh consumed in all regions in that year.

Table 1 below outlines the revenue requirements for each Transmission Network Service Provider from 1 January 2021 to 30 June 2021 in total and by month.
